REPORT ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of **EMS GREEN ENERGY PRIVATE LIMITED** ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2021, the Statement of Profit and Loss (including other comprehensive incomes) and the statement of Cash Flows for the year then ended and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.
